Dear Alumni of St. John the Baptist School:

In 2014 St. John School celebrated 100 years of Catholic Education. In recent years we have seen the need to adjust our method of tuition. In July of 2016 an education committee that solely focuses on the school was organized.

The first goal of the committee was to look at the tuition and enrollment at the school. For the 2016-2017 school year the cost to educate a student at St. John's is \$5,300.00. The committee decided to go with a set tuition of \$900.00/student for a parishioner and \$1,200.00/student for a non-parishioner. This tuition fee is in line with other outlying Catholic schools near us.

The committee believes a Catholic education is very important for our youth, but also realizes after meeting with parents that a set tuition can cause hardships. Therefore the committee has established a Tuition Assistance Scholarship Fund at Saint John's School for any family who needs financial assistance.

If you believe that a Catholic education is important to our young people, we ask that you consider helping us establish and if possible maintain this Tuition Assistance Scholarship Fund. This will help families who also believe in the value of a good Catholic education, but financially cannot afford it. Presently, there are 69 students enrolled in the 2016-2017 school year. St. John School offers a strong Catholic education that works with families to develop an understanding of the Catholic faith, morals, and culture. Grades 2-8 go to Mass and

participate in Eucharistic Adoration and First Friday Devotion every month. Mass for all grades are every Wednesday. The present pastor, Father Tom Huff, goes over to the school on a weekly basis to teach religion. All teachers bring the Catholic faith into their various subjects. In addition, the school has taken great strides to keep up-to-date with technology in the classroom.
