-Fr. Tom explained that giving the money to the teachers would result in taxes needing to be taken out of their salaries. That would mean more work for the bookkeeper which would not be an option. What the parish really needs is help paying existing payroll for teachers. Allowing the teachers to turn in receipts was discussed. Fr. Tom said this was a possibility if the parish pays for the items to reduce the tax charged by the diocese. Since PCCW already gives money to the parish, it was decided no more would be given for the teachers to purchase classroom items.
