Old Business

- 1. Lenten 50/50 and dessert results**-Linda went over the results on her Treasurer Report. There were only 3 Fish Fries due to the Covid-19 closure.
- 2. 50/50 Raffle at Christmas Bazaar in 2020 (tabled from January meeting)**-It was decided to table the discussion on this until the September meeting.
- 3. Cookbooks remaining:** 35
- 4. T shirts remaining:** 32 (6-XL, 8-L, 8-M, 10-S)
- 5. Review of PCCW group list information (members, telephone #'s, groups)**-Officers were asked to look over their list after their Fish Fry to update information. The three groups did this this year. We will do this again next year.
- 6. New this year: \$2.00 Christmas Bazaar tickets, 4 books per envelope, total \$20 if all books are purchased. \$500.00 cash donation**-It was decided to table the discussion on this until the September meeting. A question was raised as to whether the raffle tickets needed to be stapled into books, and it was decided that they did not.
- 7. Response to PCCW dues being paid with new envelope in bimonthly mailings**-It is too early to tell. \$1000 has been collected so far. The money is going directly to the parish so those paying their dues get a tax credit. A question was raised as to discontinuing dues. This was tabled for a future meeting.
- 8. Divine Mercy Sunday Collection? Will it be rescheduled?**-We are waiting for a directive from the diocese on this matter.

New Business

- 1. Will Christmas Bazaar be held due to COVID-19?**It was decided to table the discussion on this until the September meeting.
- 2. Change in how each group signs up for Lenten Fish Fry Fridays**-In the past, each group chose their Lenten Fish Fry at the June meeting. A new procedure for assigning groups was discussed. A motion was made by Kay Lehman, seconded by Arlene Schreier, that in the future we would move each group down one on the list from the previous year. See the schedule in the calendar at the beginning of this report.
- 3. PCCW officers to attend one or more parish PCCW meetings each year**-It was decided to table the discussion on this until a future meeting.
- 4. Recruiting officers**-A question was raised as to how groups have recruited officers. Individual group meetings used to be held. Those meetings are no longer held so officers rarely change.
- 5. Reaching out to older parishioners**-It was decided that PCCW will go beyond the shut-in list to send cards to older parishioners.
