Case Monitoring: The school will post the number of student and staff positive cases on the school website. Should numbers of the total staff and student population positive for Covid at any one time rise significantly, the school will enforce stricter protocol.

Points of Contact Regarding Covid-19: Principal, pastor, and parish administrator.

Weekly Schedule: In-person instruction 5 days per week for all students in grades 5K-12.

Daily Schedules for Grades 4K – 8:

Grades 4K: 7:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday)

Grades 5K – 8: 7:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Dismissal, Bus Riders: 3:00 pm

Dismissal, Non Bus Riders: 3:05 pm

Doors to enter school buildings will open for students at 7:40 a.m. each day. All students will go immediately to their homeroom upon arrival.

Morning Extended Care: 6:45 am to 7:40 am. Location: Library/Gym

Afternoon Extended Care: 3:05 pm to 5:30 pm. Location: Library/Gym/Classroom

Daily Operation Plan: A daily self-screening symptom checklist will be provided for all families, students, and staff. No one should come to school if the symptoms checklist indicates the student or staff member should remain home. Masks are being highly recommended for all students and staff by the CDC, yet not required. Masks will be available from the school if needed. If total staff and student population positive for Covid at any one time increases significantly other safety protocols may be implemented.

Physical Spaces Plan: Safety signage for hand hygiene, protective measures and symptoms awareness are displayed throughout the building. Sanitation stations will be available throughout the building. Sinks/bottle filling stations will be available throughout the building. Students should bring their own water bottle.

Healthy Environments Plan: The school has established daily and weekly protocols for cleaning and disinfecting. Staff will continue to reinforce safety protocols. (ie. Wash hands regularly, use hand sanitizer, cough in the elbow, etc.)

Transportation Plan: There will be assigned seats (per family unit) and loading and unloading protocols. The district must follow the federal transportation guidelines. Currently, masks are required on buses.

Food Service Plan:

Lunch prices for the 2021-2022 school year are as follows:

- \$2.50 Preschool - Grade 4
- \$2.85 Grade 5 - 8
- Free Employees
- Free Morning Milk Break
- \$0.35 Glass of milk

NOTE - milk is included with a meal. Should a student bring a cold lunch and desire a glass of milk, this is the price they will be charged for it.

The classes eat on a rotating basis in the Parish Dining Hall with Preschool - Grade 4 beginning at 11:45 am and Grades 5 - 8 beginning at 12:35 pm.

Student and Staff Active Cases: Positive individuals will be asked to follow **Marathon County Health Department Quarantine Options Timeline** and must be fever free for 24 hours and other symptoms improving without medication before returning to school. Students will be unable to ride the bus or participate in Edgar Public School sponsored events for 10 days from the onset of symptoms and may return to those activities after that time provided all other protocols have been met. Vaccination does not impact isolation for a positive case. Individuals with Covid related symptoms will need to be sent home. Siblings of individuals with Covid related symptoms will be checked for symptoms, if no symptoms siblings may stay in school, if symptoms exist siblings will be sent home.

Co-Curricular Activities with Edgar School District: The CDC and the WIAA highly recommend that any co-curricular participants wear a mask. Masks are highly recommended at all co-curricular events for all spectators. As many Edgar Public School events as possible will be live streamed. Any change in WIAA guidance will be followed.
